



Bona Advantage Scholarship

Students who meet the eligibility criteria will receive a scholarship equivalent to 15% of their tuition costs.

Eligibility Criteria

- Any new student fully accepted on regular status into any SBU graduate degree program who has earned a baccalaureate degree from either St. Bonaventure University or Hilbert College within the last five years* and is embarking on graduate studies for the first time. Both full-time and part-time students are eligible.
- Only new students accepted for terms beginning Spring 2003 or after are eligible.
- Students receiving graduate assistantships are not eligible for the Bona Advantage Scholarship, except if a student is taking more courses in one semester than the assistantship covers. For example, if a student is receiving a graduate assistantship that covers three credit hours in the semester, but the student is registered for six credit hours, the student will be eligible to receive a Bona Advantage Scholarship equal to 15% of the cost of the three credit hours not being covered by the assistantship.
- The Bona Advantage Scholarship cannot be used in conjunction with any other St. Bonaventure grant, concession, scholarship, or waiver.

*Students are eligible if they are enrolled beginning the term (Spring or Fall) following the fifth anniversary of their graduation. A student who establishes eligibility under the five-year window will retain eligibility for the duration of enrollment in the program of entry. Students accepted in other than regular status (for example, evaluation status) would be eligible for the scholarship for the first full semester in which they have achieved regular acceptance status.
